  Designed for the student doing library research or other special projects under faculty supervision. (Not a regularly offered class or portion thereof and not taught in a classroom setting. The student is working to earn additional credit on a semi-independent basis with occasional planning and evaluation sessions with the supervising teacher.).
- TOPICS COURSE: 287 Lower Division Level / 487 Upper Division Level

  Designed for students needing a course not listed in the regular course offerings. (A new class offered on an experimental basis or classes that are not regularly offered but that are taught in a classroom setting or combined with a regularly offered class.)
