Curated Learning: Every other month, we will promote a new learning track consisting of three hand-picked webinars.

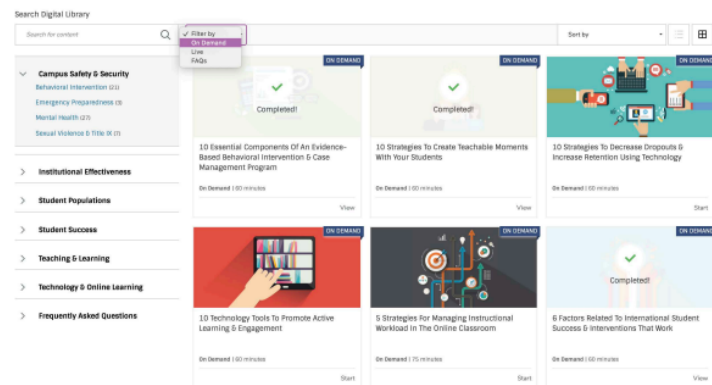


On-Site Training
